

### *David's Descendants*

Lynn,

Please do not misunderstand my admonition to you about idols: televisions, VCR, Computer games are not idols—unless you pray to them or dedicate them to the devils. These things serve real function in our lives. Some are more frivolous than others, but that is a different matter. God forbade Israel from bringing into their houses the “silver & gold” of the heathen lest they be accursed. These things were accursed because they were devoted and dedicated to devils. Evidently, those devils felt that they had a right to travel where ever their jewelry traveled, and God obviously —with only one exception-- accepted their logic on that issue. Hence, to preserve Israel, They were instructed to keep those things out of their houses. The same would apply to gods of wood and stone. If your neighbor practices witchcraft and manufactures sculptures to symbolize her religious practices, then she would be an idolater. You would be wise to never purchase any of her art work to decorate your home; you would be in violation of *Deut Seven*. Yet, if she sells apples you do not need to know her religious affiliation; if you are hungry, you may buy it and ask the Lord’s blessings. The same could be said of statues of mother Mary. These things serve no real purpose and are created for devotional prayers and protection. They are dedicated as supernatural mediums —but they have no power other than the supernatural force which the enemy can channel through them. However, if Hitachi manufactures a TV or a video game and has done so without dedicating it to the Devil, then Satan has no claim on it. These items are not manufactured out of superstition but out of scientific principles and advances which the Lord —not the devil—has instituted during the age of enlightenment. We enjoy jet planes, automobiles, telephones, TVs today because Christianity, over the past 2000 years, has sought, with the Lord’s guidance, to cast out the devil. These things come by God’s grace and by our obedience to have dominion over the earth. Therefore, your purchase is done to meet a real purpose and usefulness in your life —much like the employment of the heathen to build Solomon’s temple. But care should be taken: I once purchased a used car; in spite of the prayers and petitions to the Lord, it gave me all type of problems; it almost killed me when I was working under it. It was called a Gremlin. Such was obviously poor judgment since the car was named after a demonic, mythical creature. The Lord has since educated me to never purchase such products which honor the devil. Therefore, I do not buy “dirt devil” vacuum cleaners; I don’t not buy “red devil” home improvement products, etc. To purchase these things, as a man of God, I cannot then claim ignorance and expect God to wink at my misjudgments as those things clearly are dedicate to honor the arch enemy of Christ and man. I recommend that whatever you purchase and bring into your home, that you merely dedicate it to the Lord, and rely upon His protection. Your use of the TV and video games, unless it is done in violation of God’s laws, i.e.: playing it on the Sabbath, or watching programs which glorify Satan, is a matter of your own personal relationship with the Lord. Remember: His yoke is easy and His burden is light. You will be judged based upon you faithfulness to His commands one of which is the forbiddance to wear or to bring the accursed thing into your home.

Regarding the throne of David, the Bible and the publication is clear. They both show that the throne will be eternal but not discontinuous. There is an interruption of approximately 2600 years, a “*valley between two mountains*”. The booklet and the Bible make this point very clear. Because the church did not have its light, we have had to preside under the light of the seven churches. Since 1844, this has been our source of enlightenment; and the Assyrian has been our

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government. Both are imperfect; yet, regarding the government, we are told to give unto Caesar, that which is his, and give unto God that which is His. The church rejected God's governance through His covenant; therefore, we now suffer under the inferior judgments. But that will not always prevail; the nations, as promised by the Lord, will be blessed by the seed of Abraham (and consequently the seed of Isaac, Jacob, Judah, David, Joseph [Mary's "just" husband], David to come). Eternity does not always imply continuity. Just as the Lord's promise to Israel that Canaan was their eternal inheritance; yet, they were commanded under Jeremiah to go into Babylonian captivity—an obvious discontinuity to the eternal covenant. *Plan A* was that Israel would abide by the Covenant and resultantly always have their light. *Plan B* was that should they reject the Lord's covenant, they would reap the curses as punishment until the day when they have 'drunk the dregs and wrung them out' (Isa 51). While we suffer under the gentile social, economic, spiritual and political leadership, we have been commanded to measure every doctrine by the Word, implying that the light from Laodicea requires careful application. David has now emerged to aid Laodicea in this endeavor—hence you have the fountain.
